What is the ADS Housing Support Service?

This service is approved by Dumfries and Galloway Health and Social Services, to provide outreach and specialist housing support for people who have difficulty in obtaining or maintaining their tenancies in circumstances related to their alcohol or drug use.

Support workers can help you to:

- ◆ Settle in to your new temporary accommodation and/or permanent home.
- Develop independent living skills, such as managing finances, dealing with welfare benefit claims and general house maintenance.
- Develop an awareness of the impact your behaviour can have on those around you – neighbours, family and friends
- Reduce the harm your alcohol or drug use has on yourself or others



What Can You Expect from Us

We will work with you to identify the issues you are having problems with. This will help us to determine what help you need from us. If you are eligible for housing support, we will work together to develop a support plan, setting out what you want to achieve. We will agree the amount of support required, and also identify the most suitable member of our team available to work with you

How Will This Happen?

Depending on your needs, one or more support workers might be involved in your support. You will meet with your support worker regularly at a time and place suitable to work on your support plan. Your support is then reviewed at regular intervals.

As your confidence and abilities increase you may require less assistance. We would then discuss what other services and options might be suitable to help you get on with your life.


What About Confidentiality
